4. What are the 3 types of aggressive drivers? Quiet, Verbal, Epic

5. Up until what age should a child be in an approved child safety seat? 8 years of age or height 4' 9"

Define the following words:

traction – The gripping action that keeps a tire from slipping on the roadway.

force of impact- The force with which a moving vehicle hits another object.

potential energy- Stored energy.

blowout - The sudden bursting of a tire.

kinetic energy – The energy of motion.

engine failure- Loss of power to the engine.

friction- The resistance between a vehicle's tire and the road surface.

gravity – The invisible force that pulls objects toward the ground.

skidding – Loss of control over the direction in which your car is moving because of reduced traction.

brake failure - Loss of braking power.

centrifugal force- The force that tends to push a moving object out of a curve or turn into a straight path

hydroplaning – Loss of traction where there is a film of water between the road and tires.
